The Village Board of the Village of Alexander met at a regular board meeting at the Village Hall of the Village of Alexander located at 3350 Church Street, Alexander, New York 14005, on the 12th day of February 2026 commencing at 7:00 p.m., and thereafter a public hearing was held at 7:05 p.m. at which time and place the following members were:

WHEREAS, all Board Members, having due notice of said meeting, and that pursuant to Article 7, §104 of the Public Officers Law, said meeting was open to the general public and due and proper notice of the time and place whereof was given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 97 of the Laws of 2011 – “The Property Tax Cap” added a new section 3-c to the General Municipal Law that provides that the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by or on behalf of any local government shall not exceed two percent (2%); and

WHEREAS, in order to adopt a budget that requires a tax levy that is greater than the tax levy limit for the coming fiscal year, only if the Village Board first enacts, by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the total voting power, a local law to override such limit for such coming fiscal year only; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the Batavia Daily News, the official newspaper of said Village; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held on February 13, 2025, and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed local law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion the Village Board has decided to adopt said proposed local law.

NOW ON MOTION OF Trustee Grimes, which has been duly seconded by Trustee Newton, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Alexander feels it is in the best interests of the Village of Alexander to adopt Local Law No. 1 of 2026 entitled, “Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law § 3-c.”; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and she hereby is directed to enter the adoption of said local law in the minutes of this meeting and give due notice of the adoption of said local law to the Secretary of the State of New York.
